Do you know any female students who should do a doctorate? Let them know about the UPB peer mentoring programme 'Einblick!' (Deadline: 15 August!)

Another year of the peer mentoring programme 'Einblick!' ('Insight!') for female students interested in doing a doctorate will start in September. The programme is aimed at female students from all faculties who are in the final phase of their MA studies and are considering doing a doctorate. Mentees will regularly meet with a doctoral candidate who shares insights into academia and her experiences. This will be supplemented by selected workshops on funding your doctorate, finding a topic, and applying for a job in academia. The aim of the programme is to support mentees in making a conscious decision for or against a doctorate and, if necessary, to take first steps.
